Emissions reduction targets

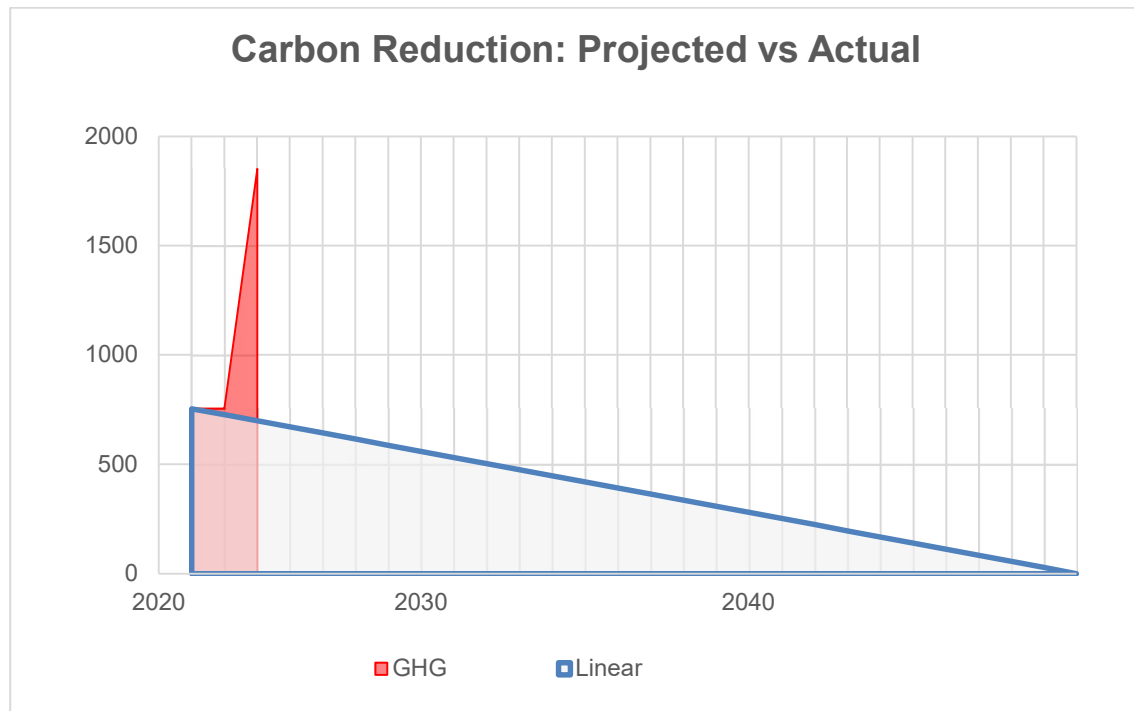
In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets:

To reach net-zero GHG emissions across the value chain by 2050

To Achieving zero emissions across our UK Operations (Scope 1 & 2) by 2035

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 1667 tCO₂e by 2030. This is a reduction of 10%.

- Invested significantly in the conversion to LED lighting in key areas of the business.
- Promotes and encourages employee uptake in relation to Electric Car Scheme
